Cleobury Residential

- Children will attend for 3 days with 2 over night stays. Either Monday -Wednesday, or Wednesday- Friday.
- They will leave school at approximately 10.30am on the first day and return to school around 2.30pm on their final day. (Children may be collected early if you wish/are able to)
- During their stay children will have the following meals provided for them.

Day 1: Evening meal (children will need to take a packed lunch with them)

Day 2: Breakfast, Lunch and Evening Meal

Day 3: Breakfast and packed lunch.

Cleobury Residential

- Groups are mixed across the whole year groups and not based on class groups.
- Children will be placed in rooms with between 2-5 beds.
- Children will be placed in friendship groups. They will have the opportunity to select 3 friends they most want to be with and we will guarantee that they will be with at least one person from their list. We try our best to include as many friendship groups together as possible.
- You will be informed in May of which half of the week your child will be attending.

Activities

Activities will be organised in groups of 10-12 children. Each group will be led by a member of the Pioneer Centre team and will have a member of school staff overseeing activities.

Children will participate in 10 activities. These may include:

- High Ropes
- Low Ropes
- Abseil/Climb/Zip Wire
- Archery
- Indoor Caving
- Raft Building
- Camp Fire
- Initiative Games
- Fencing
- Challenge Course
- ► Team Games (final activity, includes prize giving)

Activities

- Children are encouraged to participate in all activities we encourage children to try and overcome their fears and challenge themselves as much as they can.
- No child will be forced to take part in an activity that they feel uncomfortable with.
- ► The aim of the visit is enjoyment!

Payment

- The cost of the visit is approximately £230 per child.
- We do not yet have a final cost of the visit next year, but this total may increase slightly depending on coach costings.
- ▶ A non-refundable deposit of £30 will be required to secure your child a place.
- The remaining of the balance will be required by the end of April (an exact date will be outlined on Pay360)
- The balance can be paid in full or in weekly/monthly instalments whatever is best for you.

Cancellations:

- Deposits are non-refundable
- Cancellation of your child's place made within 16 weeks of the start date will be charged 50% of the original fee.
- Cancellations made within 8 weeks of the start date will be charged 100% of the original fee.
