TEATIME / TOAST CLUB TERMS AND CONDITIONS

OPENING TIMES

Toast Club is open from 8.00am until 8.40am.

Teatime Club is open from 3.15pm until 6.00 pm every night during term time.

COLLECTION

Children will need to be collected from the club by 6.00 p.m. If you are frequently late collecting your child, it may result in us withdrawing your child's place.

Please give us written or verbal details of who will be collecting your child other than yourself. It is against our policy for your child to leave the club with someone who is unknown to us. Please telephone us prior to pick ups if an alternative person is collecting your child. We require the full name of the person who is picking up the child. A proof of I.D. may be required on request.

ABSENSES

If your child regularly attends Toast/Teatime Club, please inform the school if your child is going to be absent.

OWN TOYS / PROPERTY

We do not allow children to bring in their own toys and handheld gaming devices. We will not be responsible for any property that gets lost or damaged.

BEHAVIOUR
