#### Book Corners

Every classroom has a book corner to enhance the learning environment. This area houses the free readers for the class. The texts are updated. <u>School Library and Reading Cloud</u> Children visit our school library on a rota basis. Children in Year 6 run the library.

#### Engaging Parents

Parents are informed at parents' evenings about how their children are progressing in reading and targets are given for the children to work on at home. Relevant information is also shared with parents. E.G. How to help your child read at home booklet Reading workshops have enabled parents to understand more about Reading at Uplands. <u>Reading Incentive - Starbooks Award</u> In Year 3 and 4 when the children have read 6 reading books and completed 6 reading journal activities they go to the Reading Champion teacher, who looks at and discusses their journal activities and then the children choose something from the reward box.

<u>Reading Incentive - Starbooks Award</u> In Year 5 and 6 the children complete a random reading gem weekly. The class teachers then choose one winner and they go to the Reading Champion teacher, who looks at and discusses their journal activity and then the children choose something from the reward box.

#### Tests - NGRT

These reading tests are completed in September and February. They are multiple-choice answers. These tests give the children a reading age and a standardised score.

#### <u>Tests - Headstart</u>

This reading test is completed in the Autumn Term. These are set out with a text and a range of questions on the domains. The children get a scaled score.

### <u>Part 2</u>

We encourage all pupils to read widely to develop their knowledge of themselves and the wider world we live in. By the end of the Key Stage, it is our intention that children enjoy reading, read fluently and are able to discuss the texts they read.

## Tests - Reading Fluency

Reading Fluency is tested across the school. Those children who do not read 90 words per minute are tested every half term to see if their speed and accuracy has improved.

## Tests - Comprehension

The LA have produced some reading tests that are similar to the Year 6 end of Key Stage Test. We are using these across school in the Spring and Summer term. The children get a scaled score.

#### <u>Assessments</u>

Day to day assessments take place on Book Talk sheets. Staff assess how well their group has read and focused on the chosen Reading Gem. In the front of the children's English book, are our Stepping Stone target cards, which are filled in when the reading target has been completed.

#### Enhancements

At Uplands we also enhance reading by: Celebrating Word Book Day, inviting authors into school, organising book fairs, sponsored events, taking part in an annual performance poetry competition, getting children to choose books for their book corner or our school library and much more...
