Year 3



In the autumn term, children will look at the artistic work and styles of the Ancient Egyptian tomb painters.

During the spring term, children will learn about the style and work of silhouette artist Kara Walker. Kara is an American contemporary artist, whose work encompasses a number of different media and styles, covering a range of themes.





Henri Rousseau will be the artist focussed upon during the summer term. Rousseau was a French post-impressionist artist, known for his painting, particularly those depicting jungle scenes.

Year 4

During the autumn term, children will learn about the style and work of petroglyph artist Teyjah McAren. Teyjah is a Canadian contemporary and abstract artist, whose passion for cave paintings and paintings on stone is like no other.





Year 5



Henry Moore will be the artist focussed upon during the autumn term. Moore was one of the most important British artists of the twentieth century. His bronze, semi-abstract sculpture work can be seen all over the world. He is also celebrated for his war art drawing work.

During the spring term, children will look at the artistic work, styles and techniques of the Ancient Saxons and Vikings.







In the summer term, children will learn about the style and work of Dan Fenelon. Dan is an American graphic artist, muralist and sculptor. He takes inspiration from ancient cultures and is celebrated for his modern day works based upon Mayan culture.

Year 6

In the autumn term, children will look at the artistic work, styles and techniques of various Heraldic artists.





L. S. Lowry will be the artist focussed upon during the autumn term. Lowry was a British naïve artist. He is renowned for his industrial paintings, depicting Pendlebury but also painted landscapes and mountains.

During the summer term, children will learn about the style and work of Andy Warhol. Andy was an American magazine and advertising artist and illustrator, who was one of the leaders of the visual art movement. He is most famous for being a pioneer of Pop Art culture.
